Dear Parent/Carer

Further to my letter on Friday 13 March, I would to stress the importance of following the government's advice regarding Coronavirus. Should your child display any of the following symptoms, it is crucial that you keep them at home, and they self-isolate for 7 days:

- A high temperature – they feel hot to touch on your chest or back
- A new, continuous cough – this means they've started coughing repeatedly

If they are not displaying these symptoms, they should be in school as normal.

Should your child start to display any of the symptoms whilst in school, we will contact you to come and pick them up. It may be that we air on the side of caution in these circumstances, as I am sure you can understand.

Please be assured that we continue to follow government and Public Health England advice. The guidance to schools may change in the coming days and weeks and we will communicate with parents/carers should this happen.
