Dear Parent/Carer

**RE: Year 11 Literature Intervention**

We are writing to you to inform you that we have identified your child for extra English Literature revision in preparation for the GCSE English Literature mocks and examinations in the summer.

To allow us to help your child to achieve or exceed their Flightpath in English Literature, we have set up an extra English Literature revision session which will take place every Wednesday morning during registration in the restaurant. This session is compulsory and your child will be informed as to who is leading their session, the venue and that they are required to attend. The sessions will last for 5 weeks and the focus will be on Unseen poetry, An Inspector Calls and their prose text (Jekyll and Hyde or a Christmas Carol). The first session will take place on **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

We have suggested to the students that they bring highlighters to the sessions and that all additional revision notes or resources that they make during these sessions are looked after so that they can be referred to during personal study either for class tests, mock exams and the GCSEs themselves.

For additional revision support we recommend either CGP or York Notes revision guides which are available to support all of the AQA English Literature texts that we study and the AQA English Language course. We would also suggest using Andrew Bruff who creates his own Youtube clips which cover all aspects of the English Literature courses which will support your child's revision. If you would like to discuss suitable revision material for your child, please do contact their English teachers.
