Dear Parent/Carer

At the time of writing, we have only been back in school for four days, but it seems that there has been a huge amount taking place. Our Year 11 students have been taking their GCSE mock examinations, for which, most students have taken at least 10 examination papers over the course of this week. As a parent, I am sure you will be aware about how well your child has prepared for these examinations, but I have to say, from our end the students have conducted themselves in an exemplary manner. With only about 10 school weeks remaining until written examinations commence for real, the feedback from this experience is going to be crucial in learning how to improve ready for the summer. We will be running a 'Mock Results Day' on Monday 18th March, where the students will pick up their results just as they will in August. On Thursday 21st March, we have our second Year 11 Parents' Evening, which I hope parents will be able to attend.

On Monday of next week, the options process will start for our Year 9 students when they will have an assembly and receive their options booklet. A reminder that it is a 7pm start for parents with students in G1, G2, L1 or L2 and a 7.45pm start for parents with students in M1, M2, S1 or S2.

This Sunday evening, some of our students will be performing in the Jack Petchey Glee Club Challenge Final, which is taking place at the London Palladium. I know a lot of you will be going to support our students and I look forward to seeing you there. If they perform as well as they did in the regionals, they should stand a decent chance, fingers crossed!

We also have a couple of trips taking place, with our Year 10 Art students visiting the Portrait Gallery on Friday and our A-level Media Studies students attending a 'Media Live' event at Disneyland Paris. I'm sure both trips will be highly enjoyable that the students will get a lot from.

Next week, we also have our Drama Festival taking place, which involves students from Year 7 through to Year 10. The evening starts at 7pm in the Theatre and if you haven't purchased a ticket yet, there are still some available. These can be purchased through the 'Positickets' website.
