## Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium

Catch-up premium funding is received by the school for all students who join us with a key stage 2 scaled score of less than 100 for either English Reading or Maths. Funding for catch-up premium is based upon the funding from previous years. This does not mean an individual entitlement to the funding, rather that the school has the discretion to spend this money to ensure that identified students are able to make the necessary progress.

### Proposed Expenditure 2019-20

Funding expected to be in line with previous years £13882 (to be confirmed Autumn 2019)

- Maths Mastery programme = £4000
- Hegarty Maths (homework support) = £1000
- Peer Reading programme = £2000
- EAL Learning Packs = £382
- English & Maths Intervention = £6500

### Impact 2018-19

For the 2018-19 academic year, we received funding of £13500 for the 56 Year 7 students who achieved a scaled score below 100 in their Reading SAT test and 78 students who achieved a scaled score below 100 in their Numeracy SAT test.

The impact was as follows:

Maths	78	57 (73%)

### Evaluation

Intervention has been very successful, particularly in reading. Students requiring further support have been identified and interventions put in place for the current academic year.
