<p>If an assessment objective has been omitted at subject cohort level please briefly outline the reasons why:- All AOs have been assessed however, pupils will not be assessed on Paper 3 – this covers practical skills. This is due to the limited time available to deliver the practical work. All elements of this have been covered theoretically but many not in their practical context would disadvantage students. Many elements of practical skills have been assessed in previous assessments where they fell within topic assessment or papers from Year 12 Assessment (AS level mocks) at the start of Year 13.</p> <p>Outline the rationale for the choice of assessment evidence used, i.e. why the evidence above was used and how it supported the grading decision:- Evidence stream 1-4 covers all content taught across the 2 year course. Combined with evidence stream 5, it shows where students have worked independently to improve knowledge and understanding from first teaching to final assessment.</p>
